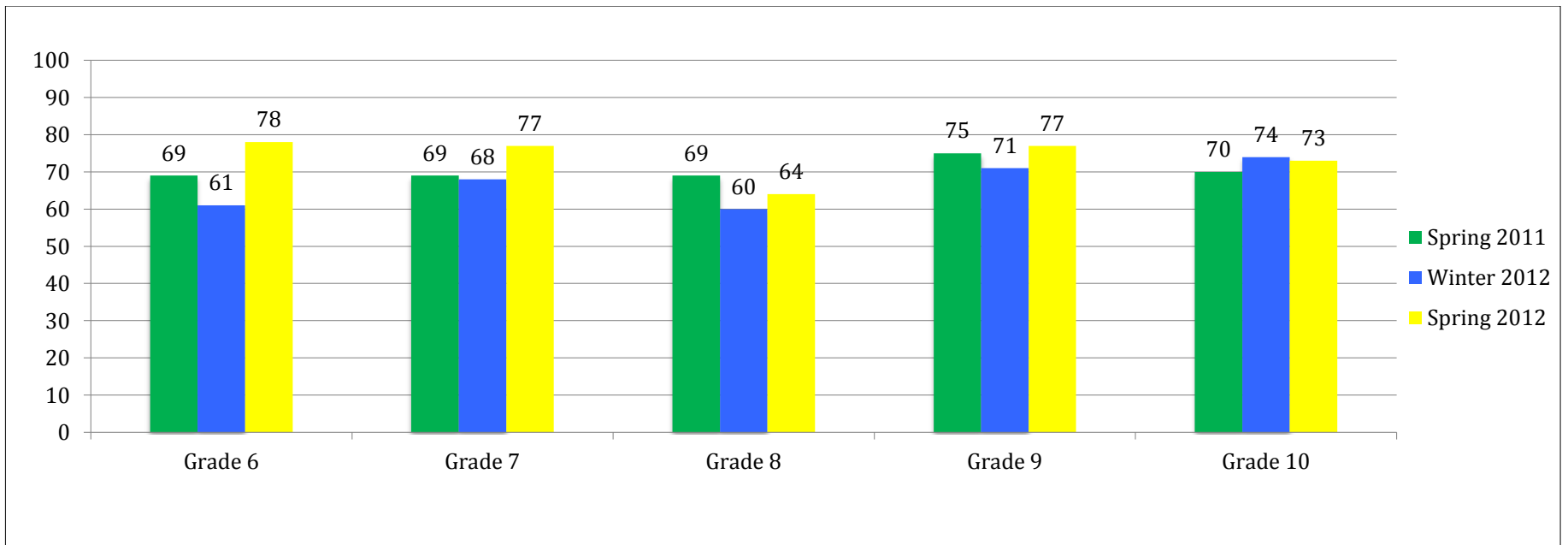
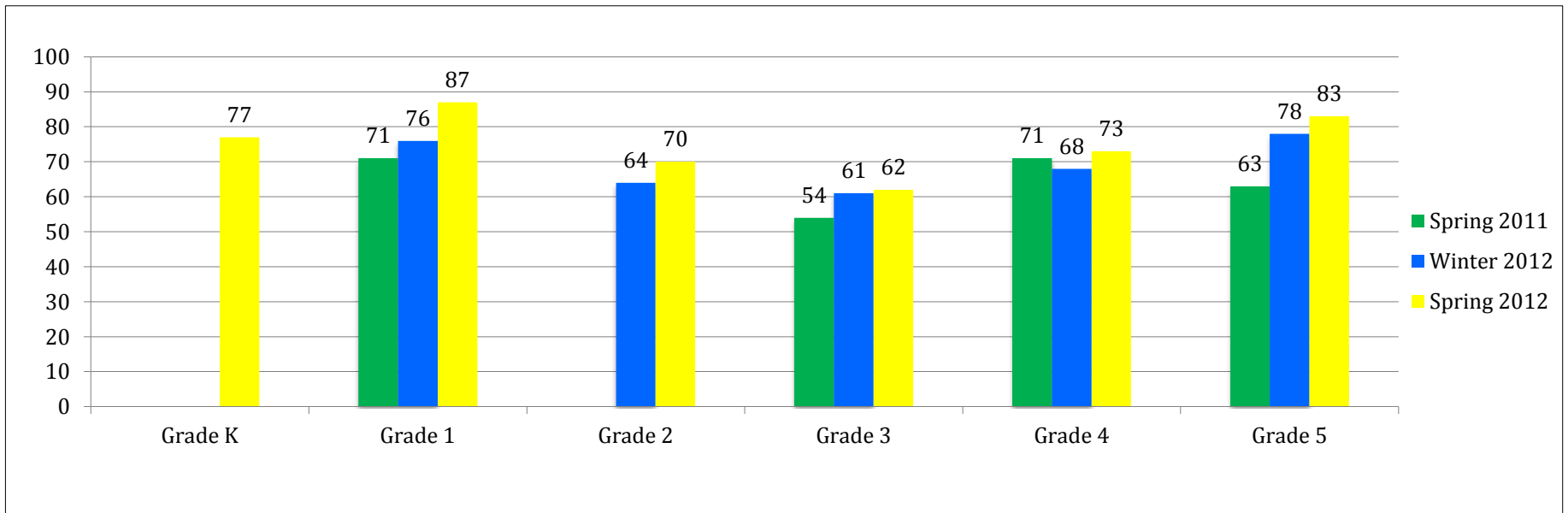

Explanatory Notes:

- *Performance norms for grade one students are derived using developmental standards from the Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA), the Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS), and Fountas & Pinnell early literacy assessment protocols. The Progress Monitoring Study for grade one includes progress reporting for reading only and tracks performance levels for fall, winter, and spring within the same academic year. Kindergarten reading performance data is only reported for the spring of the Kindergarten year.*
- *Performance norms for grades two through ten in reading and mathematics are derived using the Northwestern Evaluation Association (NWEA) Measures of Academic Progress (MAP). Assessment results for RSU 13 students are compared to normative data derived from the 2011 NWEA RIT Scale Norms Study. This study included sample data for 20,000 students per grade randomly drawn from a record pool of 5.1 million students involving 2,700 school districts in 50 states.*
- *The RIT Scale (from which student RIT scores are determined) is a curriculum scale that uses individual item difficulty values to estimate student achievement. The RIT scale is an equal interval scale. Equal interval means that the difference between scores is the same regardless of whether a student is at the top, bottom, or middle of the RIT scale and it has the same meaning regardless of grade level. For the purpose of this report, mean RIT score performance is utilized to assess the degree to which students meet or exceed established norms. Individual student performance is defined by a RIT score determination calculated as a single score, and also as a likely range of performance derived from a calculation of the standard measurement of error. For the purposes of this report, if the established norm fell within a student’s likely RIT score range of performance, then the student was identified as meeting the performance norm.*
- *2009-2010 was a pilot year for this report and that report remains available on the RSU 13 website. The report for 2010-2011 was expanded to include information regarding on-going performance results for grade one students in reading, the numbers of students receiving level one (Tier I) Response To Intervention (RTI) services to remediate significant performance deficits, and also to include spring reading performance data for kindergarten students. Beginning with 2011-2012 reporting for grades two through ten will detail progress data in reading and mathematics for spring of the previous testing year, and winter and spring of the current instructional year.*
- *Please note, NWEA/MAP testing in grade two is the first ‘formal testing’ experience for students at this grade level, and undoubtedly contributes somewhat to over-all depressed performance scores at this level for initial mid-year reporting.*

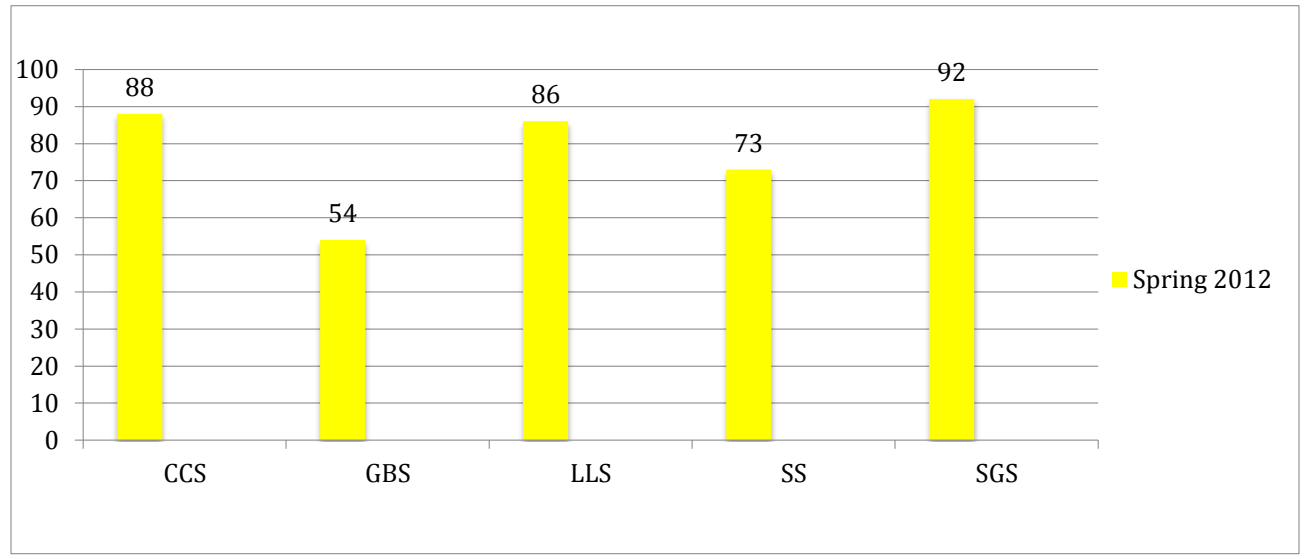

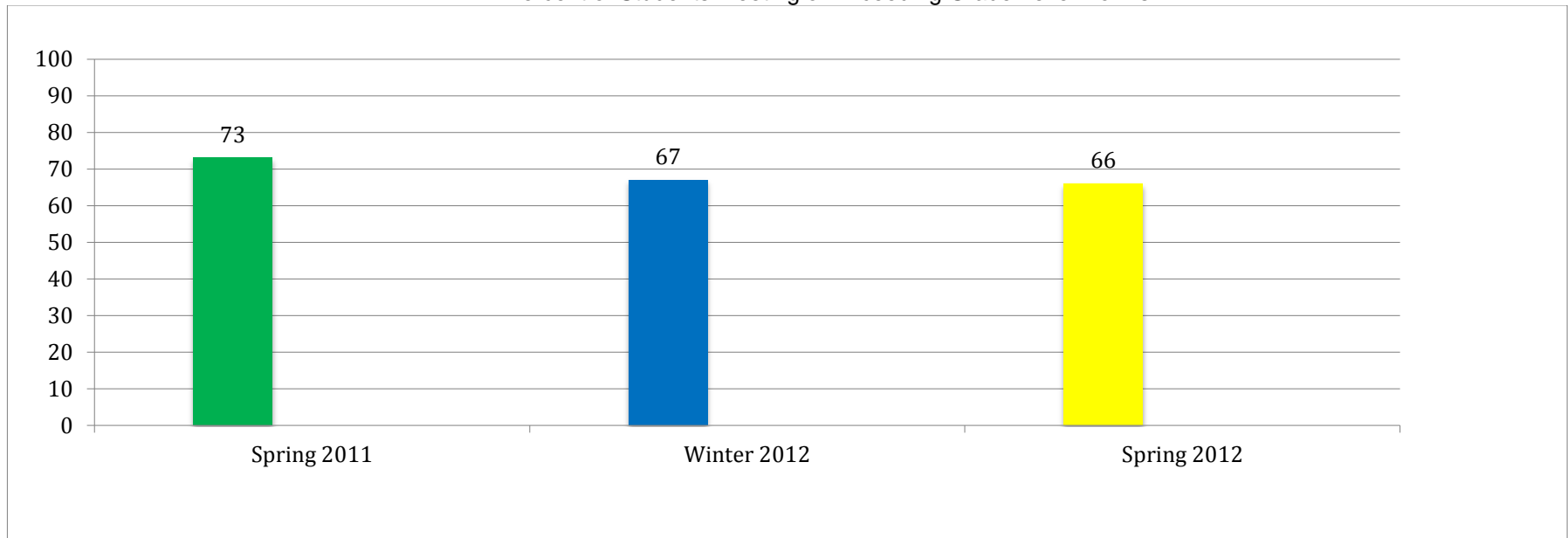
